
Clean fittings before lubricating.


Clean parts with SOLVENT, Dry-cleaning, Type II, (SD-2). Dry before lubricating.

Drain crankcases and gear boxes while the lubricant is still warm from previous use. Refill and check level.

4 CRANKCASE. Every 1200 hrs drain system, wash cronkcose, oil cooler, filter pumps and piping with OE/HDO. Filter oil and return to system. Drain and refill. Every 2400 hours or every year whichever occurs first.
